

Middle School Schedules

- Our school year is split into two parts (semesters).
- All 6th Graders take 6 classes each semester.
- 4 Core classes, which are taught in teams
 - Math & Science (1 teacher)
 - ELA & Social Studies (1 teacher)
- 2 Encore classes
 - Also known as "electives"
 - Some are student choice



6th Grade Encore Classes

- Health and Fitness (1 semester) is required.
- Students may choose from the following options for the remainder of their schedule:
 - ESE: Exploring Secondary Electives -Art, Technology, Drama, Leadership, AVID (1 semester each, on rotation)
 - Band (year-long)
 - Choir (year-long)
 - Orchestra (year-long)

Course Registration

- 1. Student placement data and teacher input are used to determine Core course placement.
- 2. Encore ESE classes are assigned at random on a rotation.
- 3. ELA and Math Academic Support classes will take the place of an elective.
- 4. Schedules will be finalized prior to the 1st day of school.
